tdmp — dump system state into core file

**SYNOPSIS**

**tdmp** [ *korefile* ]

**DESCRIPTION**

*Tdmp* reads the state of the system as it was saved on DECTape (drive 1) when the system "panic'ed" producing a dump of all of memory starting at block 0 on the DECTape. If no *korefile* is specified, the dump is put in the file "kore" in the current directory.

The "kore" file is suitable for debugging with *kdb*.
